### AN OUTSTANDING ACADEMIC PROGRAMME

We are one of the few schools in Hong Kong to offer A-Levels and our results in this globally recognised qualification are consistently amongst the best in the world. By choosing A-Levels, students' knowledge, understanding and skills are deepened thanks to the programme's in-depth subject content. Students normally study three subjects during their two years in the Sixth Form. There are currently 22 subjects available to study:

#### WELLBEING

Wellbeing at Kellett is both proactive and reactive. Our deep and wide pastoral infrastructure, including trained counselors, works to mitigate and react to situations, whilst our Positively Kellett curriculum focuses on equipping students to thrive when faced with life's challenges. Delivered to all Sixth Form students for a lesson each week, Positively Kellett addresses a wide range of topics such as relationships, rights, philosophy and responsibilities, helping students to become informed, critical, responsible, healthy and active citizens.

#### **MINI MBA**

Kellett's Mini MBA has been developed and is delivered in partnership with IE Business School in Madrid, rated by the Financial Times as providing the best online MBA in the world. This is a practical class designed to provide a simulated experience of building a startup. The goal is to create an entrepreneurial experience for the student. The course is delivered by Professor Leticia Ponce Hernández who is the Director of the IE University Startup Lab and an Entrepreneur and Angel Investor.





# **EXTENDED PROJECT QUALIFICATION (EPQ)**

To give students the opportunity to focus on their passions, many of our Sixth Formers undertake the EPQ, an in-depth piece of research which involves producing a 5,000-word essay. If students receive top grades in their EPQ, some universities such as York, Bath, Cardiff and Exeter make slightly lower

#### **CRITICAL PERSPECTIVES**

Critical Perspectives lessons encourage students to delve into critical thinking and hard questions, as well as introducing them to subjects they may not have previously encountered, such as Philosophy, Sociology and Evolutionary Biology. Similar to university study, the course is delivered through lectures, student-led presentations and seminars, with reading and discussion time.


#### **SIXTH FORM LIFE**

Our facilities include a state-of-the-art Sixth Form study suite with a fully equipped kitchen and common room, allowing our oldest students to form a strong community in a comfortable environment. ## RESPONSIBILITY & INDEPENDENCE

Reaching the Sixth Form is a significant milestone in a student's education, and as such students are given greater responsibility, as well as more independence and privileges. Sixth Formers are supported by a dedicated team of staff all of whom are members of ISCA and IACAC the key associations for international school counseling. In addition, the school offers a range of highly sought after leadership opportunities to lead at the ECA, Subject, House and whole school level. Around half of the Sixth Form will take on a leadership role during their two years.

### UNIVERSITY & CAREERS GUIDANCE

Many of our students gain places at the world's leading universities including Oxbridge, the Ivy League and in Hong Kong. Our Careers and University Guidance team, including a specialist in highly selective university entrance, provides one-on-one guidance to help students make the right decision about what and where they study after Sixth Form, and their career pathway.

The team oversees an impressive enrichment programme to support students applying to highly selective universities, as well as those applying to a range of courses, including the Arts, Medicine (and associated BMAT & UCAT preparation), STEM, the Humanities, Law, English and the Earth Sciences.
